

OAK STREET TOWNHOMES URBAN RENEWAL PLAN

- Applicant MarCor Holdings, LLC
- Affiliated with Sunflower Development Group
- Plan is the development of 19 2 – 3 bedroom townhomes
- Application received prior to affordable housing requirement

Blighting factors include:

- Garbage & trash
- Overgrown weeds & brush
- Erosion from storm water runoff
- Deteriorating sidewalks & curbs
- Multiple property code violations

- Staff recommend approval of a Finding of Blight
- Staff recommends approval of the proposed Oak Street Townhomes Urban Renewal Plan & forwarding it to City Plan Commission and City Council for approval






6. BENTON INFILL 30 – 45 URBAN RENEWAL AREA




Incentive Area: Benton Infill 30-45 URA / Council District: 3

- Example of scatteredsite Urban Renewal Plan
- URP created in 1991
- Non-profit community development corporation led effort
- Sixteen parcels
- Twenty-one homes built

- All tax abatements have terminated
- Staff recommend termination of URP
- City Council approval will be needed






7. GRAND MCGEE URBAN RENEWAL AREA





Incentive Area: Grand McGee URA/ Council District: 4








